Problems or Repairs:

- 1. SCENERY The masonite on the tip of the tail of one of the commas got caught one someone's shoe during the show and flipped up. The SM team drilled a screw into the end and covered it with white gaff tape. The masonite feels secure and safe for the remaining performances.
- SOUND Sound cue 85 is listed as bringing in Sasha's motif and cue 86 is listed as bringing Sasha's motif out and the department store music back in. We noticed tonight that Sasha's motif doesn't come in when cue 85 is called, it just cuts out the department store music which comes back in with cue 86.
- 3. PROPS The two red gems on Queen Elisabeth's golden sword fell off while setting up before the show. The SM team found a hot glue gun backstage and re-glued the gems back on.
- 4. COSTUMES Could we get longer lacing for Orlando's corset? Paige Verbsky noted tonight that she is experiencing some tenderness in her ribs after wearing it throughout this past week.
